
JESUS? WHO IS AND WAS HE? REALLY?

HERE IS WHO JESUS IS

(Repetitions do occur)

Jesus is 100% God and 100% man. (*John 1:18 and 14:7-11*) As Jesus was in his whole person, thoughts and feelings that's how God is. (*John 1:14 and 10:38 – Luke 10:22*) Jesus is the only way to God and eternal life. (*John 14:6*) He lived the perfect life in your place. (*All of the gospels*) You have sinned (*Romans 3:21-31*), but he never sinned. He was the only one qualified to offer his life as an atoning sacrifice and make a way for believers to be forgiven. He was seen by many of the disciples after his resurrection.

(All of Luke 24, all of Mark 16. 'and all of John 20 and 21)
He said that he did not come into the world to judge us who believe, but to save us from eternal damnation. (John 3:16) and that those who do not believe, God will judge because they have not believed in the only begotten Son of God (John 3:18) Jesus was sent by God - as your only savior. - He went to Heaven and now sits at the right hand of God, from where He now judges the living and the dead. (Mark 16:19), but also sends us the spokesman (The Holy Spirit) to help us. (John 14:15-21)

The gospel of John 3:16-21

(Also called - "The little bible")

¹⁶ For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

¹⁷ For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. ¹⁸ He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

¹⁹ And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.

²⁰ For every one that doeth evil hated the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. ²¹ But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.

WHEN COMPARING ISAIAH'S PROPHECY WITH WHAT ACTUALLY HAPPENED TO JESUS, WE WILL IN MAIN FEATURES GET THIS OUT OF IT:

Jesus became like us. - He was rejected by men – condemned --- punished - hated - whipped - tortured - and he suffered and was crucified - He died but rose again,

- so we can be accepted by God as his child. (John 1:12)
- so we can become like him. (Romans 13:14 Galatians 3:26-27)
- so we can be forgiven. (Matt. 6:14-15)
- so we can be strengthened. (Luke 22:32, Acts 14:22, 15:32, 16:5, 18:23 and many more of the letters)
- so we can be healed. (*Luke*. 5:15, 1. Peter 2:24)
- so we can be loved by God. (John 14:21)
- so we can be justified by faith in Jesus. (Rome 5:1)
- so we can be comforted and have peace of mind. (John. 14:27)
- so we can live. (Matt 4:4, Luke, 10:28, John 11:24)

He descended to the realm of the dead Acts 1:18, where he got the "keys" of Hell and of death (Revelation 1:18), that we may enter heaven and avoid hell. (Matt.25:31-46 = The Judgment of the world) He endured the wrath of God that we deserved for our sins so that we could enjoy the good that otherwise only Jesus deserves. (Matt. 27:46)

THIS IS WHAT WE GET SAVED TO

A PERSONAL MEETING WITH JESUS

- **1. RECOGNITION:** All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. (Romans. 3.23) God! be merciful to me a sinner! (Luke 18.13). In the light of God's word, it is realized that we are sinners.
- **2. REPENTANCE:** We must have a sincere desire to break with sin once and for all. If you do not repent, you will perish in the same way (Luke 13.3). Therefore, change your mind and repent, so that your sins may be blotted out. (Acts 3.19).
- **3. CONFESSION:** The Lord is waiting for our confession of sin and for us to show faith. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and fair, so He forgives us our sins and cleanses us from all unfairness. (1. John 1.19) when you confess Jesus as Lord with your mouth, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. (Rome. 10.9).
- **4. FAITH:** Faith in Jesus finished work on the cross. God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. (John 3:16)

Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. (Mark 16.16)

You must accept Jesus Christ in your heart by faith and believe that God raised Him from the dead before you experience the reality of the new spiritual birth in your life (John 3:1-13) - - "He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. But to all who received Him, He gave power to become children of God. (John 1:9-13)

PRAY OF YOUR HEART THIS BELOW OR A SIMILAR PRAYER AND BE SAVED:

"Dear Jesus! I want to belong to you. and I ask you to forgive me my sins. Take me completely and become Lord of my life. With your help I will repent of my sins and confess you to other people".
